## A NOTE ABOUT COOLER TEMPERATURES!!!

It's getting chilly outside! Please remember that our students will go outside for recess every day, even when the weather gets colder. (If it is actively raining or there is other extreme weather, or if the temperature is below freezing, we will provide indoor recess activities.). With this in mind, make sure your student dresses appropriately for the weather. This includes warm coats, hats, and gloves, and – as always – shoes that are suited for active play and which may get dirty.
