Towanda Recreation Center Update

Creative City has been participating in community conversations about the future of our Recreation Center. We are so excited that Towanda will be getting a partial renovation and a new focus on community programming once it re-opens. While the gym will remain the same, the other multi-purpose rooms will be renovated and, in some cases, reconfigured. The playground area will also receive an update, although the input process around that space has not yet begun. The center is expected to be closed through the summer and potentially into the fall. Creative City has been assured that we will regain access again once it is open next year, and we will continue to provide our school community with periodic updates.
