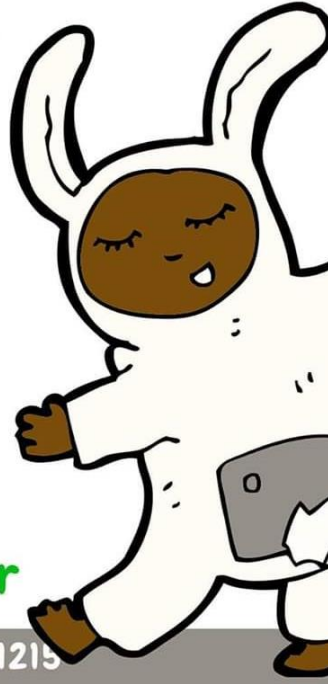

Car Line Reminders!

To keep kids safe, to respect our Park Heights neighbors, and to respect all parents' very valuable time, please remember the following during morning arrival & afternoon pickup:

1. Join the car line via Grantley Ave so that all cars join at the end of the line and do not back up on side streets
2. Park in legal spots only - no double parking or in alleys. There is also parking in our Lower Lot.
3. Stay with your car in the car line and never leave your car!
4. Keep in a single line. A double line is dangerous for kids!
5. Car Line Traffic is ONE WAY ONLY. All traffic enters near the cafeteria and exits at the Shirley Avenue traffic light.
