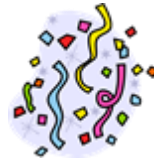

ATTENTION: NEW DISMISSAL POLICY

We follow the Baltimore City Public School calendar during bad weather events. Decisions to close are usually made by 6am. If there is a two-hour delay, that means we start at 10am. If the two-hour delay occurs on a Wednesday, Wednesday follows a full day schedule and we will dismiss at 2:45pm instead of 12:45pm. Breakfast is not served on days with delayed openings. After school programs (including UEC) are cancelled if we dismiss early.
