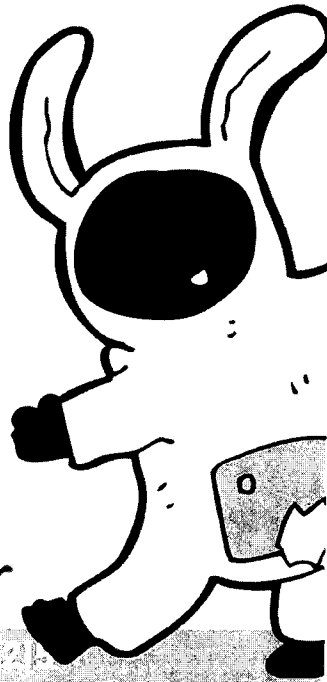

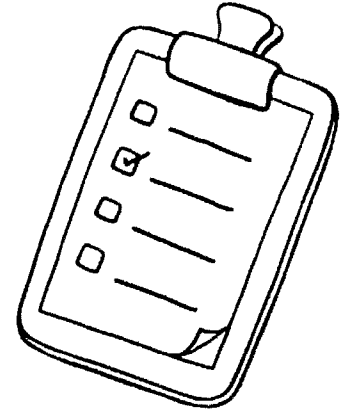
Outdoor Classroom Work Weekend!

Your Child's Attendance Matters!

According to research cited by AttendanceWorks.org,

- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10 percent (or about 18 days) can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.
