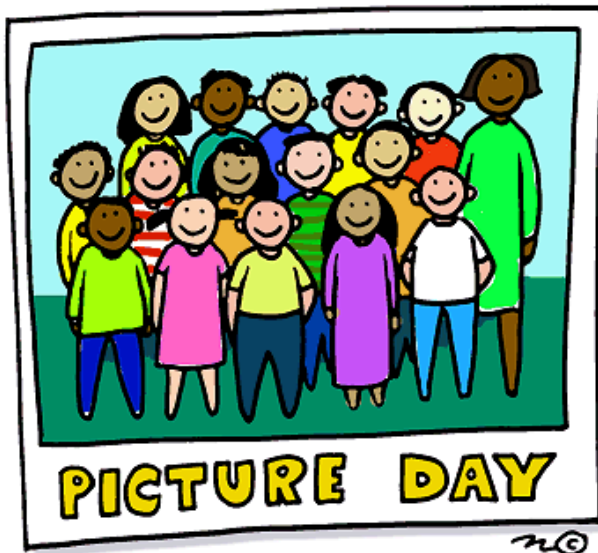


Picture Day is this Friday October 06, 2017
