Classroom Spotlight

Ms. Spencer's Science Classes



Last week, in conjunction with Blue Water Baltimore, MD Association for Environmental Outdoor Education, and the National Wildlife Federation, Ms. Spencer's 4th and 5th grade science classes planted a pollinator garden in the Outdoor Classroom. Last spring, Blue Water Baltimore came and assessed where would be the best place to plant a 100 square foot garden. The garden includes asters, coreopsis, purple coneflower, and milkweed. These flowers attract butterflies, bees and other insects who work to pollinate all sorts of plants to help them grow. The students learned why pollinator gardens are important for entire habitats and ecosystems. Ask your child about this wonderful experience!
