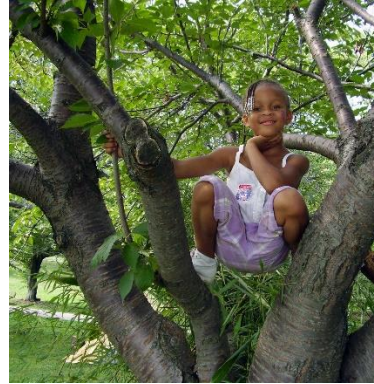
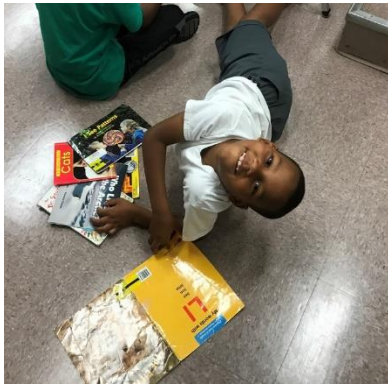


# SEEDS OF KNOWLEDGE

### What is the format of the program?

The program is set to be virtual with some in person socially distanced and safe service learning projects on Saturdays. The Saturday service-learning component will be held in-person at the Parks & People Foundation campus (2100 Liberty Heights Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21217). We are constantly monitoring COVID metrics, state and federal guidance to determine the safest way to deliver this high-quality program.
